
Please use the provided envelopes.

Life happens, and all too often we get busy, our routines morph over time, and sometimes we just need to do a "reset". If you find yourself in this situation, and you feel it is time to catch-up on your offering envelopes, here are some, hopefully, helpful facts:

† The various envelopes: Easter, Ash Wednesday, April 6th, November 13th, etc. are to provide a calendar point of reference for the giver.

#All the collections, or donations, go into the same place from an accounting perspective...the bank. It doesn't matter what envelope is used, it all goes to the same place. If your name and/or envelope number is on the envelope, you will receive credit.

†Special designations, such as Building Fund, Campership, Discretionary Fund, or other specific cost center, all go the same bank, but are separated out into the various budget centers in our ledger.

\$\\$So, in summary, it is not necessary to send in a bunch of missed envelopes with a check or cash in each. One envelope will do the job. You may note on the envelope if some portion of your donation is to be directed to Building fund, etc.




Photo Directory
